L&T Wins Award for Excellence in Power Project Execution

L&T has won the Award for Excellence in Power Project Execution from the Central Board of Irrigation and Power (CBIP), a Government of India institute, for its outstanding contribution to the development of the Power Sector in India.

The award was presented by Prof. Sanwar Lal Jat, Minister of State for Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation, to Mr. Shailendra Roy, Whole Time Director & Sr. EVP (Power, Minerals & Metals), on January 1, 2015, at New Delhi during the CBIP Day Celebrations.

The citation lauds L&T's execution of Nabha Power's 2x700 MW supercritical thermal power plant at Rajpura, Punjab, in a record time. This project is India's first full EPC job completed using indigenously manufactured supercritical Boiler-Turbine-Generator equipment.

The event was attended by an august gathering that comprised Ms. Uma Bharati, Minister for Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation, Mr. D. Choudhary, Special Secretary, Ministry of Power, Mr. Major Singh, Member (Planning), Central Electricity Authority, and CMDs, and other senior officers from Public Sector Units and State Electricity Boards.
